
FLEET SAFETY LETTER 123020.GEN

Applicable to: This FLEET SAFETY LETTER should be brought to the attention of ship-owners, ship managers, operators, Masters of Vanuatu-registered ships and Recognized Organizations

IBC Code Amendments affecting the Transport and Handling of Hazardous and Noxious Liquid Substances in Bulk on Offshore Support Vessels

1. The latest amendments to the International Code for the Construction and Equipment of Ships Carrying Dangerous Chemicals in Bulk (IBC Code) were adopted by IMO Resolutions MEPC.318(74) and MSC.460(101) and come into effect on 1 January 2021.
2. Guidance on the timing of replacement of existing IBC Code certificates by revised certificates as a consequence of the entry into force of amendments to chapters 17 and 18 of the IBC Code has been published as MSC-MEPC.5/Circ.7/Rev.1.
3. The approved guidance with regard to the replacement of an existing certificate by a revised certificate advises to issue the revised certificate before the entry into force of the amendments to the IBC Code.
4. Notwithstanding the entry into force date and the guidance approved by IMO, and considering the impact of the amendments, Vanuatu Maritime Services Limited (VMSL), the Administrator of the Registry, accepts the application of the current carriage requirements onboard Offshore Support Vessels until 31 March 2021.
5. Products which have been amended are permitted to be carried under the current carriage requirements until 31 March 2021 provided that these products are listed on the existing approved cargo list.
6. OSVs must meet the IBC Code amendments for any request to add new products to the cargo list on or after 1 January 2021.
